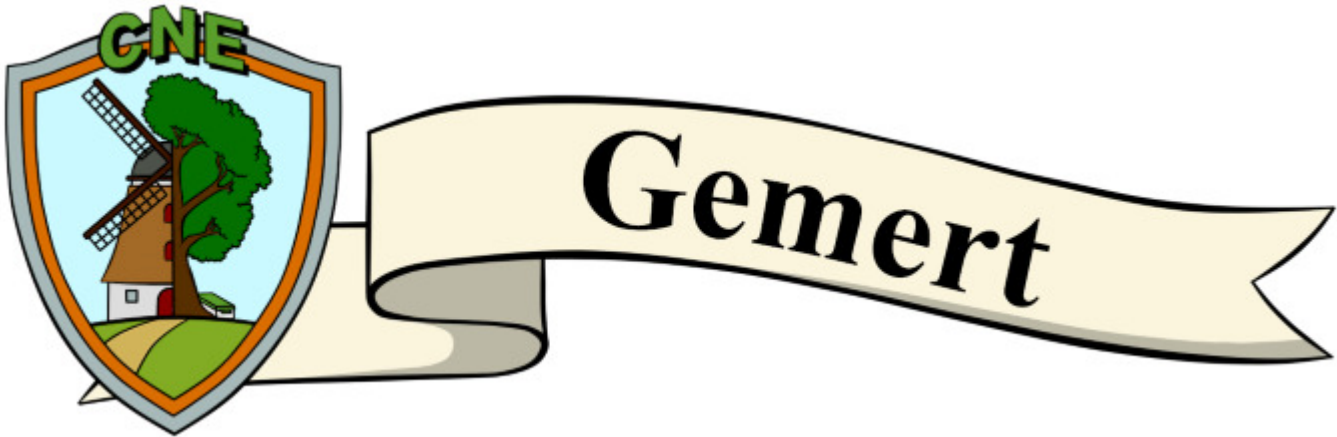

[CNE25] The Red Guild

The Sint Jorisgilde Gemert has 40 members in its formation and another 99 elders. Every two years there is a battle for the Kingship of the Guild. The first to shoot the bird from the shooting tree may call himself King of the Sint Jorisgilde for two years. The home base of the Sint Jorisgilde, or 'de Rooi Skut', is café Dientje in Gemert. This is also called 'the Gildehuis'.

The Sint Jorisgilde was founded at the beginning of the sixteenth century. Read more about the history of the guild here. The guild owes its name to the patron saint Saint George. Saint George is best known because he is often depicted fighting a dragon. Every



year on April 23, the name day of George is celebrated. The connection of this patron saint to the Guild means that 'de Rooi Skut' celebrates its annual feast day, also called 'optrekdag', every year around April 23. On this day, the Guild welcomes its 'new dean', a new member among the Guild brothers.

Walk from the Kampen over the footpath to the chapel. Along this path are two beech trees, each with its own sign in front of it. One of these trees was planted during the solemn blessing.

On what date was this blessing? The day = A

Walk further to the square in front of the entrance. There are a number of red benches here.

How many people can

sit at the same time? This = B Now walk around the chapel clockwise. Various facade stones are incorporated in the walls.

How many years has W. vd. Vossenberg been almost captain? This = C

Walking further, you will see a beautiful relief of Saint George and the Dragon. Below that is a Roman numeral.

What is the value of the third character. This = D

Toon Opsteen laid the first stone.

On what date is that? The day = E

Now walk inside. Take a look around and answer the questions. Do have respect for your fellow human beings. Take it easy and do not damage anything.

How many guild heads can you count in the chapel. This number = F

There is also a beautiful and colorful medallion to be seen here This is the coat of arms of the Sint-Joriscgilde.





How many animals do you see on this medallion? Look very carefully. This number = G

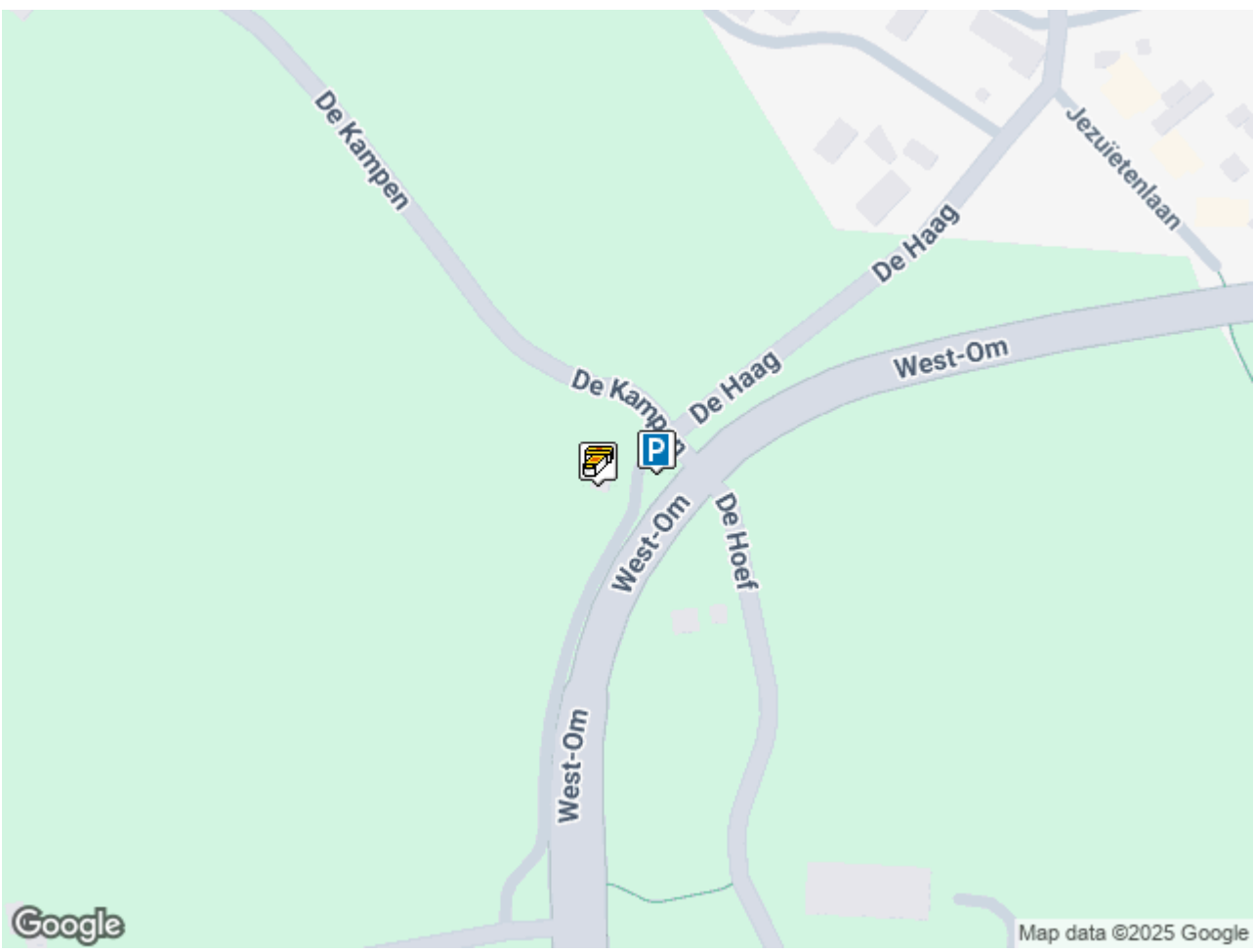
