

[CNE25] The Peelrand Fault

The Peelrandbreuk is a fracture in the earth in a relatively soft soil.

This is unique in Europe. The municipality has, in collaboration, designed the GEO park so that everyone can enjoy it.

The most recent earthquake was on 13 April 1992. The peak was approximately 4 km. southwest of Roermond at a depth of 15 km. The earthquake lasted 15 seconds and was felt up to 400 km away. Because the peak of the earthquake was very deep, you could not see much more than a few sand fountains on the surface.



The Peelhorst is the part that goes up and was itself too wet and inaccessible for construction. A typical fracture phenomenon is that the high side is wet, and the low side is dry. The edge zone was attractive. The edges were literally sought out for construction. On the other side of the fracture it was often dry. The area was less suitable for living at that time. Hence the large differences in the landscape. In the Netherlands, the fault runs roughly from Roermond to Oss and separates the higher Peelhorst from the slowly sinking Roerdal Slenk.


