

[CNE25] Farmers' Union - The Forge

A forge was an essential workshop in towns and cities, where the blacksmith played a central role in daily life. It was a place full of fire, sparks and the loud sound of hammers on the anvil. Here are some features of such a forge at that time:

The Workshop

Appearance: Often a small, stone or wooden workshop with an open door or large windows for ventilation. The floor was usually of packed earth or stones.

Equipment: The forge had a large hearth (or fire pit) in which coal or coke burned, a blower (usually a hand- or footoperated bellows) to fan the fire, an anvil, and various hammers, tongs, and files.

Smell and sound: There was a typical smell of burning coal fire and molten metal. The sound of the blacksmith working the iron with his hammer could be heard from far away.

Work of the Blacksmith

The village blacksmith made and repaired all kinds of metal objects such as horseshoes, agricultural implements (ploughs, harrows, hoes), wagon parts, fences and kitchen utensils. He shod horseshoes with horseshoes, a heavy but important task. Many blacksmiths also specialized in tools for craftsmen such as carpenters and shoemakers.

Sometimes he made decorative wrought ironwork such as gates, candlesticks and signs.

The Blacksmith as a Village Figure

The blacksmith was a respected craftsman, often an important figure in the community. People came not only for work, but also to talk and exchange news. He usually worked with one or more apprentices or servants, who learned the trade by working with him.




