

You have the keskes and you have the keskes.

I want to make a clear distinction between the keskes on the Lodderdijk and the keskes that mark intersections and junctions here and there in Gemert. Those on the Lodderdijk are unique and sketch the Way of the Cross, which at that time was taken by Jesus Christ at a different, somewhat more southern location, from Pilate's house to Golgotha. The images and captions in the 'wayside chapels' capture the famous story in words and images in such an edifying way that a boy who was raised outside of any religion, walking along the Lodderdijk, makes up for lost time that is unparalleled in church history. Yes, that last sentence does indeed have a high biographical content and is, you are right, a bit exaggerated.

The kèskes in the Kruiseind, on the Stereind and in the St.-Annastraat form the triangle within which 't Gimmert of old was located. The street scene of the late 19th, early 20th century, Catholicism, devotion, the ribbon village where the kèskes demarcated the ends of the 'Straot', the occasional driver who manoeuvres his horse and cart past such a kèske, as a reference point (behind the kèske you had to turn right, into the Deel, then you would come to Boekel) and as a meeting place (oh durske, I see you so much, will you come back to the kèske?). All these images contribute to the

time machine effect. Nostalgia mixed with a lack of sense of reality. That mixture is actually unnecessary, because nostalgia is a lack of sense of reality.




