This route takes you through the Korte Duinen nature reserve. Over a distance of 4.5 kilometers, you'll find 12 caches. Numbers 8 and 12 are bonus caches, the coordinates of which can be calculated using the bonus codes at the top of the logbooks. You are free to walk on the roads and paths in this nature reserve. Dogs must be kept on a leash. Have fun!

**On Thursday, he ate his way through four strawberries. But he still wasn't satisfied.**

Who doesn't love strawberries? They're sweet, juicy, and very healthy. Strawberries contain vitamin C and antioxidants, among other things. The best part: homegrown strawberries taste even better. And they're very easy to grow, both in the garden and in pots, containers, or bags. The most important thing is that they get enough sun and nutrients.

You can sow or plant strawberries. Sowing requires a bit more work and can be done from February onwards. They need moist soil, sunlight, and warmth to germinate. Because it's still too cold outside, this must be done indoors. After the Ice Saints, the plants can go outside. The Ice Saints fall in mid-May and mark the time when there is no longer a risk of night frost. Strawberries grow well in almost any soil, as long as it's not too wet and contains plenty of fertilizer.

There are two types of strawberries: single-bearing and everbearing. Single-bearing strawberries produce fruit for 3 to 4 weeks, usually in June. They flower first, and only then do the strawberries appear. Everbearing strawberries produce fruit for a longer period, from July to September. With these varieties, the plants flower and harvest simultaneously. By combining both varieties, you can pick strawberries for up to four months. Bees and bumblebees also ensure that the blossoms are pollinated and that fruit can develop.

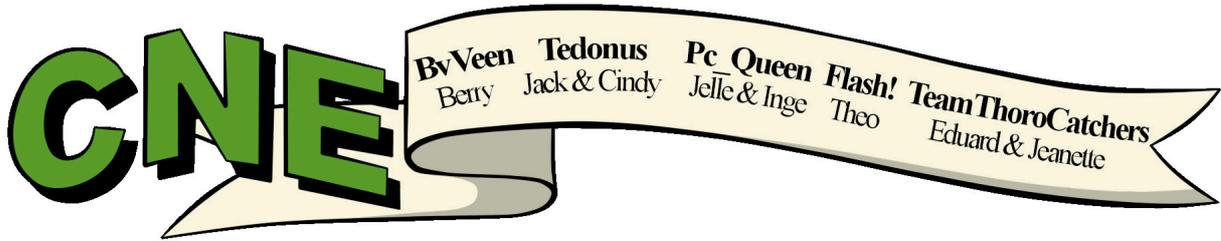
After about six weeks of growth, the first strawberries are red and ready to be picked. Strawberries are picked when they are completely red. Not only do people love strawberries; birds also enjoy feeding on them when they are ripe.

After two to three years, strawberry plants become less productive. Fortunately, they produce new plants themselves via runners. From the second year onwards, you can use them as new plants.

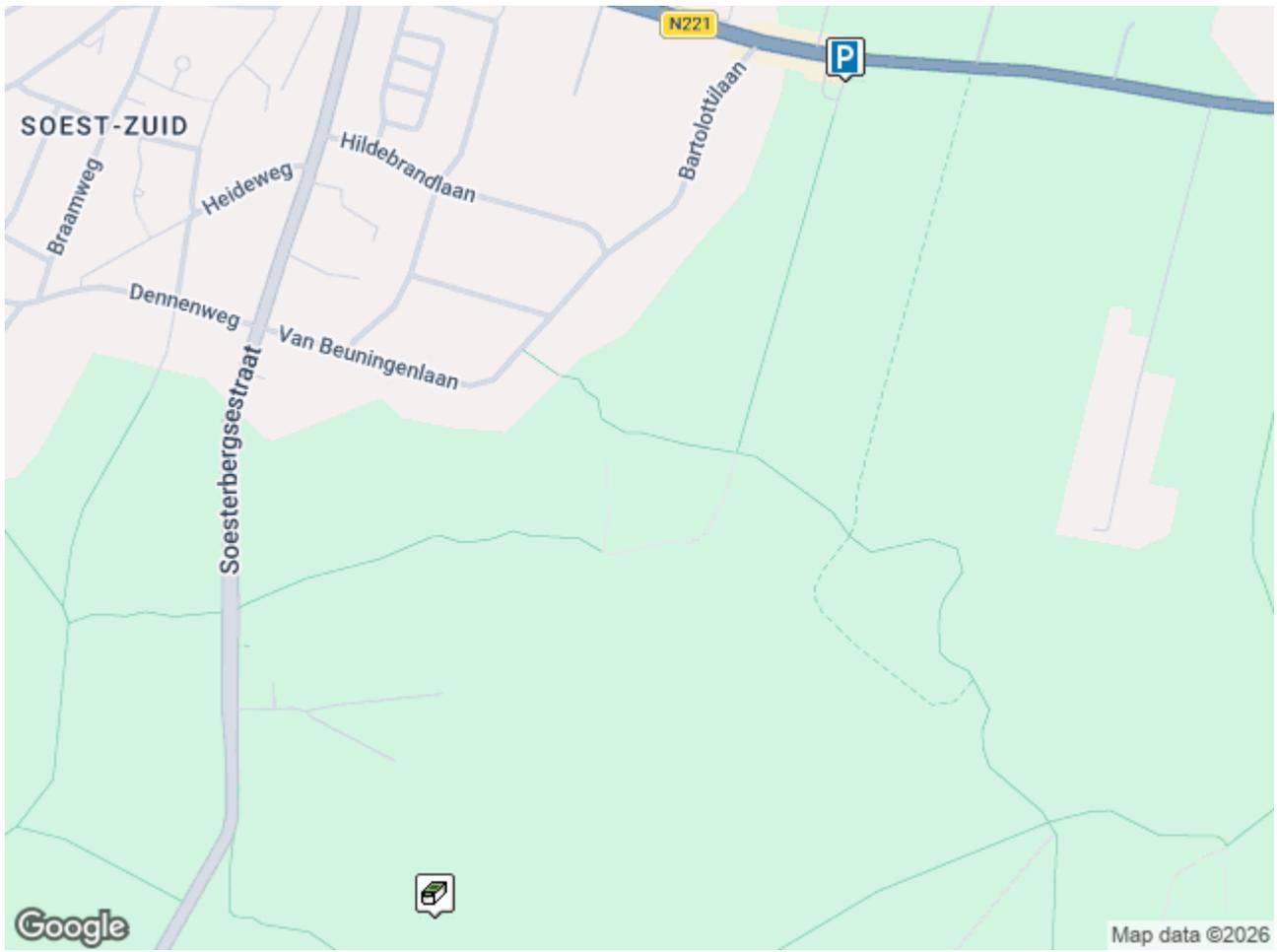
