
This route takes you through the Korte Duinen nature reserve. Over a distance of 4.5 kilometers, you'll find 12 caches. Numbers 8 and 12 are bonus caches, the coordinates of which can be calculated using the bonus codes at the top of the logbooks. You are free to walk on the roads and paths in this nature reserve. Dogs must be kept on a leash. Have fun!

On Friday, he ate his way through five oranges. But he still wasn't satisfied.

Oranges grow on orange trees, a tree found primarily in warm, sunny regions. Cultivation usually begins with a young, grafted tree, as growing from seed is time-consuming and produces unpredictable results. In spring, the orange tree produces white, strongly scented flowers. These flowers are pollinated by insects such as bees. After pollination, the flower falls off, and the fruit begins to form as a small green ball. Oranges grow slowly and require plenty of sunlight, warmth, and water. It takes an average of six to twelve months for the fruit to fully develop. During this period, the orange usually remains green. Only when the nights cool does the peel change from green to orange. This color difference doesn't always indicate ripeness: in warm, tropical regions, oranges sometimes remain green even though they are still sweet and ripe. Once the oranges are fully ripe, they are harvested by hand. They do not ripen further after picking, making the right harvest time crucial.


