

Caterpillars are very picky about food. Most caterpillars only eat one type of plant, or plants that belong together. Such a plant is called a host plant. Without these plants, caterpillars cannot survive. That's why host plants are very important in a butterfly-friendly garden. It's also important that these plants haven't been sprayed, because poison can kill caterpillars. Some caterpillars eat only one type of plant. Others eat a slightly wider variety, and still others eat many different plants. There are even caterpillars that would rather die than eat something they don't know. Most caterpillars eat leaves, but not all. Some caterpillars eat roots, others live in plant stems. There are caterpillars that can even live underwater, safely nestled in the stem of a plant. Still others live under the bark or in the wood of trees. There are also caterpillars that eat only seeds, or flowers. These caterpillars are often well-hidden because their color resembles that of the flower. Some caterpillars eat moss, algae, or even dead leaves on the ground. Finally, there are caterpillars that eat other caterpillars. They usually only do this when food is scarce, but some species do it constantly. So you see, caterpillars live and eat very differently, but they all need one thing: the right plant to live on.


