This route takes you through the Korte Duinen nature reserve. Over a distance of 4.5 kilometers, you'll find 12 caches. Numbers 8 and 12 are bonus caches, the coordinates of which can be calculated using the bonus codes at the top of the logbooks. You are free to walk on the roads and paths in this nature reserve. Dogs must be kept on a leash. Have fun!

Eventually, the chrysalis bursts open, and the butterfly emerges. The wings are still wet and folded. Because the butterfly cannot yet fly, it is very vulnerable. Body fluids cause the wings to grow larger and harden. Only then can the butterfly fly and search for food. The lifespan of a butterfly varies from a few days to two or three weeks. There are also butterfly species that live for several months and hibernate. These are the exceptions, because most butterflies in the Netherlands spend the winter as eggs, caterpillars, or chrysalises. They hide somewhere in the grass, among plants, or under fallen leaves. The butterfly species that hibernate are always the first to emerge in the spring sunshine. During their lifetime, the most important thing for butterflies is to find a partner to lay eggs with. Because that's how they survive!




