The trail of progress

The history of the former Amersfoort station begins in 1863, the year the Utrecht–Zwolle railway line opened. This gave Amersfoort its first direct connection to the national rail network. What began as a relatively modest stop quickly grew into a major hub for both passenger and freight transport.

In the second half of the 19th century, the railway profoundly changed the city. Raw materials such as coal, wood, and grain were transported by train, while local products found their way to other parts of the country. Workshops, warehouses, and new businesses sprang up around the station. The railway became a driving force for industrialization.



A significant milestone followed in 1904 with the opening of the Amersfoort Carriage Workshop. This large railway workshop, located a short distance from the station, employed hundreds of people and transformed the city into a hub for railway engineering and maintenance. The combination of the station, yard, and workshops remains a core area of industrial heritage to this day.

During World War II, the railway area suffered severe damage, particularly in 1944, when Allied bombing raids targeted the rail infrastructure. After the war, reconstruction and modernization followed, with old functions disappearing or being repurposed.

Although the station has been modified and relocated several times over the years, traces of its industrial past are still visible in the buildings, lines, and structures. This place tells the story of steam and steel, of labor and progress—and forms the backdrop for this cache.

- 9/ Hoeveel ramen zie je boven de cirkel? Dit is I


Oost $00(B)^\circ (C + H + I + 2).(A \times D + C \times F + G \times H + I) \times 3 + 53$
