## [CNE26] DBZ #06 Little Switzerland BONUS

This cache is located in the Bergkwartier district, which is divided into De Berg-Zuid and De Berg-Noord.

The Klein Zwitserland forest area is located in the De Berg Zuid district, which is also the origin of the abbreviation DBZ in the cache title. If you want to visit all the DBZ and DBN caches in a single walk, it's approximately 10 km. The Klein Zwitserland loop (5 traditional caches with a bonus) itself is approximately 2 km.

Welcome to the beautiful Klein Zwitserland forest area. This relatively small forest area is characterized by its many elevation changes. These elevation changes were mainly created during the penultimate ice age (200,000 - 125,000 BC). Glaciers from the north pushed further and further inland, and the resulting pressure pushed the ground upward. Below this, moraines formed, of which the Utrechtse Heuvelrug is a good example. The area you are currently in is known for the Amersfoortse Berg (highest point 44m above

During this beautiful walk, it's definitely worth taking a look around. This woodland is home to the tawny owl, the great spotted woodpecker, the nuthatch, and the green woodpecker, among others. Crested tit and black tit are popular near conifers. At the forest edges, you can spot various characteristic butterflies, of course, in the right season.




