[CNE26] Sewage pumping station

Welcome to an inconspicuous yet crucial piece of technology in the Randenbroek neighborhood. Many people walk or cycle past here daily without knowing what's happening beneath their feet or behind these walls. We're standing here at the Sewage Pumping Station at Bachweg 48.

What is a sewage pumping station?

A sewage pumping station is a vital link in our modern hygiene. Because wastewater can't always flow naturally downhill to the treatment plant, this pumping station pumps water from surrounding neighborhoods

upwards or further on to the wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) of the Vallei en Veluwe Water Board. Without this pumping station, the basements in Amersfoort-Zuid would quickly become waterlogged!

Industrial Heritage

Although this building appears functional, its location on Bachweg is of cultural-historical value. The pumping station on Bachweg has been designated as a valuable industrial heritage site within the municipality of Amersfoort.

The architecture of such utility buildings from the mid-20th century reflects Amersfoort's post-World War II growth. The pumping station recalls a time when large-scale urban expansions like the Randenbroek district called for a modern, centralized approach to water management. The careful integration into the green surroundings and the brick architecture are characteristic of the architectural style of that period.


Be aware: It can be busy here with "Muggles" (cyclists and walkers). Stealth is essential!


