The building at Verhoevenstraat 89 is a tangible remnant of Amersfoort's early industrial development. At the end of the 19th and beginning of the 20th century, the city grew rapidly, and the demand for reliable food production increased.

It remains a striking building, a reminder of a time when milk didn't always arrive chilled from the supermarket. This building was once a steam dairy: a place where technology, food production, and industry converged, where milk was processed using steam engines. Through heating and mechanization, quality was improved and production increased—a huge advance in an era when hygiene and shelf life became crucial.

With this Mystery Cache, you'll delve into a piece of Amersfoort's industrial heritage and search for traces of the past that are still visible on the building facades.

History of the steam dairy factory

At the end of the 19th century and the beginning of the 20th, Amersfoort grew rapidly. Demand for dairy products increased, and modern processing became necessary. Steam-powered dairies played a key role in this.

In this building milk was:

heated and processed using steam engines

checked for quality

stored and distributed to stores and customers

The factory was part of the early food industry, which provided better hygiene, longer shelf life and greater production capacity.

Over the years the building's function changed several times:

first as a steam dairy factory

later as storage and work space for related companies

subsequently as a place for small-scale industry and crafts

$$N 52^{\circ} 08.(A \times 2 + 1) + 550$$


$$E 005^{\circ} 22.(B \div 3) \times 10 + (A \div 12) + 543$$


