Welcome to an area where the scent of railway oil and the echo of shunting locomotives have hung in the air for over a century. The Bokkeduinen Depot is more than just a train parking lot; it's a vital part of the industrial heritage that has made Amersfoort the railway hub of the Netherlands.



The History of the Railway

When the first trains reached Amersfoort in 1863, the city transformed from a quiet trading center into a logistics powerhouse. While the iconic Wagon Workshop (built between 1904 and 1924) for freight wagon maintenance was built across the tracks, the site at the Bokkeduinen served as the silent, indispensable partner for staging and shunting rolling stock.

Industrial Heritage in Motion

Where coal smoke once filled the air, you now see modern Dutch Railways trains resting between their services. Yet, the historic lines are still visible:

The Ensemble: Together with the nearby monumental buildings such as the Veerensmederij and the Rijtuigenloods, this area forms one of the coolest industrial ensembles in the Netherlands.
Signal Box Post VI: A replica of this pre-war signal box has been a reminder since 2025 of the complex technology required to safely guide hundreds of trains per day to their destination on the Bokkeduinen.

The Cache


You don't need to enter the closed railway yard to find this cache. Follow the paths along the edge of the Bokkeduinen and observe the dynamics of the track from a safe distance.


