[CNE26] Isselt

The Isselt industrial estate isn't just a business park. It's one of Amersfoort's oldest industrial estates, where production, storage, and transport have been taking place since the late 19th century.

Thanks to its location on the Eem River, close to the railway and a short distance from the city center, Isselt grew into an indispensable link in the city's economic development.

With this cache you literally stand on historic ground, where industry and city have met for generations.

Origin and growth

At the end of the 19th century, Amersfoort began to grow beyond its old city limits. Isselt was one of the first places where large-scale industry could establish itself.

Raw materials arrived by ship on the Eem River and by train on the railway, while finished products found their way to the rest of the Netherlands. This combination of water, rail, and space made Isselt unique and progressive for its time.

Working on the city

Over the years, numerous companies have been active in Isselt, including:

transshipment and storage companies

food industry

metal and mechanical engineering

energy and water-related companies

Thousands of Amersfoort residents found work here. Isselt thus became a place where people worked hard every day to contribute to the city's growth.

Industrial heritage

Although Isselt has always been on the move, traces of its industrial past are still visible:

old commercial buildings, quays and waterworks, railway remains and infrastructure

These elements make Isselt an important piece of industrial heritage, showing how the city developed from a fortified town to a modern working town.

Current use and future

Today, Isselt remains a vibrant business park, but it's also undergoing significant change. Old industry is partly making way for: repurposing buildings, innovative businesses, a focus on sustainability, and connecting with the city and the Eem River.

Isselt thus remains true to its origins: a place where work and development are central.


The cache is placed in a secure, public location. You don't need to enter any unauthorized areas, and you won't disturb any businesses or employees.


