## [CNE26] Amersfoort Shopping City



Amersfoort is a popular shopping city. There's a wide variety of shops and eateries. There are several well-known large chain stores, but there are also many local shops. Combined with the historic character of the medieval city center, it's almost always busy here. Langestraat, along with Kamp, forms the longest shopping street in Amersfoort. This was quite different in the thirteenth century. Back then, it was a main thoroughfare with a city gate on either side. The Kamperbinnenpoort (Campyard Gate) still serves as a reminder of this. Where the Rodepoortsbrug once stood, near the Varkensmarkt (Varkensmarkt), you can still find an original sprengel (sprinkler) used to collect water from the canal. For centuries, Langestraat was the city's most elegant street. Amersfoort's elite lived here, as evidenced by the beautiful buildings with their facade stones. When most residents moved to villas outside the city in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries, the properties were sold to shopkeepers. Gradually, it evolved into the shopping street we still see today.

To complete this multi, you'll need to pay close attention. The photos spelling "Amersfoort" were taken between the two waypoints. Each letter comes from a shop window, billboard, or sign. The location of the letter in the name is its value. If the letter appears more than once on the sign, it's the first letter, unless it's clearly a different one. Once you've found all the letters, enter the value into the formula to determine the cache. Have fun searching in this lively street.

**Here's another example:**



Here you see the "O" of a well-known chip shop in Amersfoort. This "O" is the 12th letter on the front of this building. So 12 is also the value here.

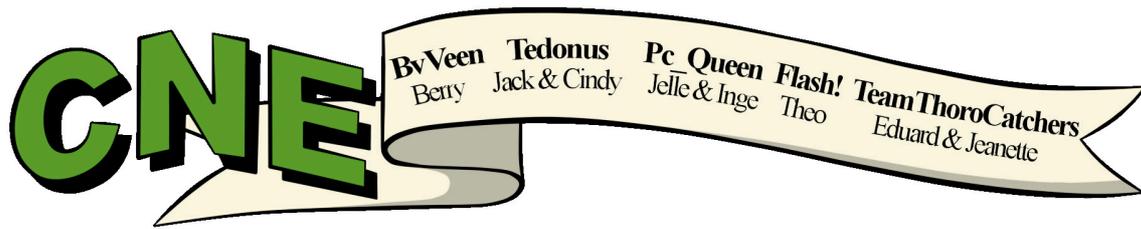

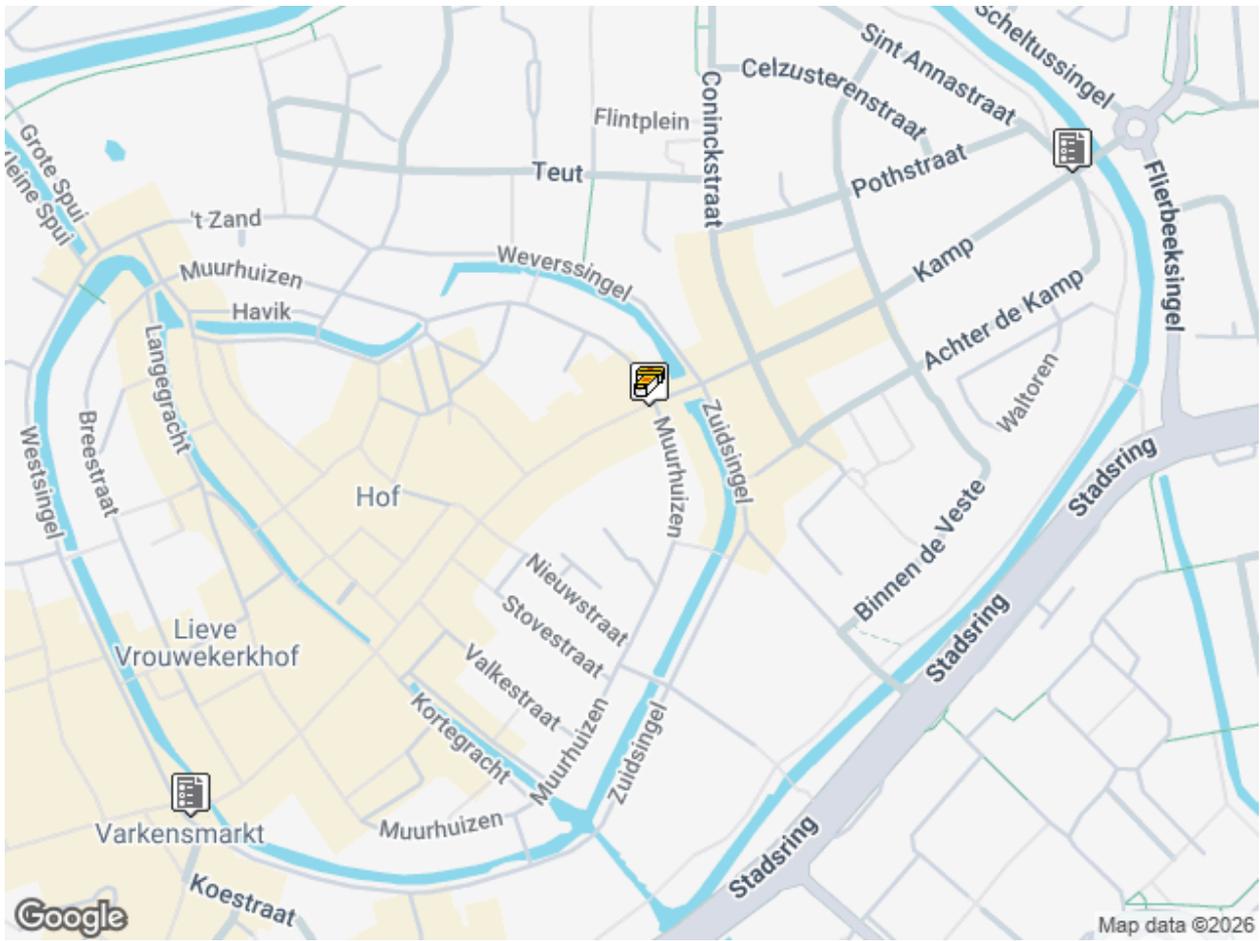
